Milk banking in the Prairie and Dairy States

1. Non-profit milk banks are regulated by the Food and Drug Administration.
2. Milk donors are never blood tested.
3. Current research demonstrates that antibody levels are significantly lower in retort-processed milk (shelf stable milk product) versus pasteurized milk.
4. Donor milk can only be used in the neonatal intensive care unit.
