

STAND Against Cancer



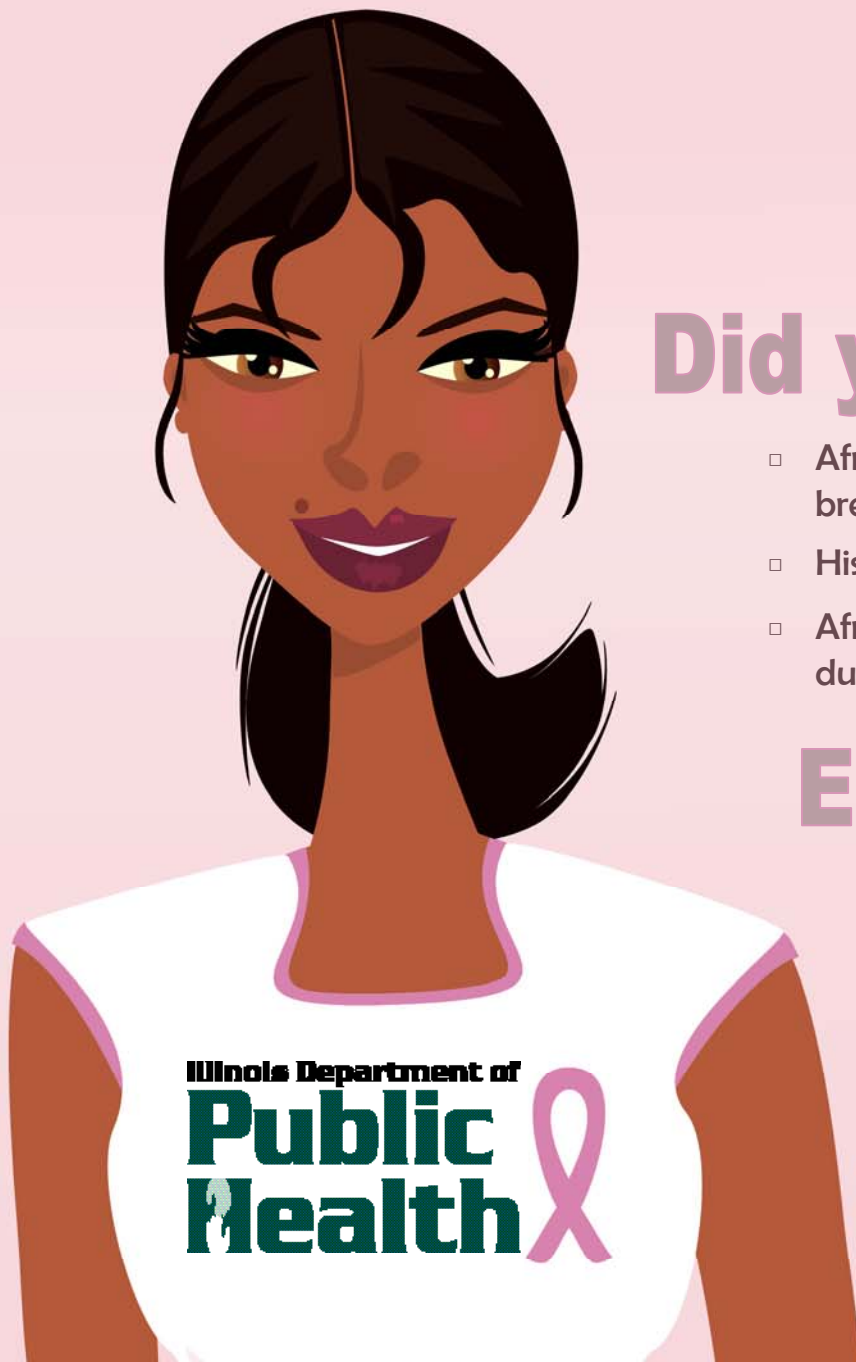
Did you know . . .

- African American women have a 36% higher chance of dying from breast cancer.
- Hispanic women have a 50% higher cervical cancer mortality rate.
- African American & Hispanic women have a higher mortality rate due to later diagnosis resulting from barriers in accessing care.

Eligibility Requirements:

- **Resident of Illinois**
- **18 – 39 years old**
- **Low income** (at or below 250% of the Federal poverty level)
