

## Approved Adjunctive Eligibility Resources

The following are the Department approved resources for assessment of adjunctive eligibility as explained in IL WIC PM CS 4.3.

Approved Resource	Description
<b>Medicaid Title XIX, SNAP, or TANF Notice of Decision Letter</b>	<p>“Notice of Decision” letter is mailed to applicant informing them of their eligibility for benefits one time per year. The notice:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• would indicate they are approved for benefits</li> <li>• would indicate eligible time period – a start and end date</li> </ul> <p>** Notice of Decision letters will not indicate Title 19 vs. Title 21 cases however agencies may enroll participants with this letter.</p>
<b>Manage My Case</b>	<p>Verify applicant’s Medicaid, SNAP, or TANF benefits using the “Manage My Case (MMC)” at <a href="http://www.abe.illinois.gov">www.abe.illinois.gov</a> . Assist the applicant in using their ABE account to Login to MMC:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• While in the WIC office, choose “This is a public computer”.</li> <li>• To verify Benefits:               <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Scroll down on the Case Summary tab to view the “What is the status of my benefit programs?” area. Click the “Food Assistance Program Details” link.</li> <li>2. In the “What is the status of my Food Assistance Program benefits?” section Click “Click Here for Details” link.</li> </ol> </li> <li>• Account and contact information on file can be verified on the “Contact Information” tab.</li> </ul>
<b>Medi System</b>	<p>Local agency staff may access the Department of Healthcare and Family Services (HFS) “Medi” system to determine if an applicant has an active Medicaid case paid with Title XIX (19).</p> <p>To be determined income eligible via Medicaid Adjunctive Eligibility the case must:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Be active at the time of the WIC appointment: review “begin date” and “end date”.</li> <li>• “Title XIX” listed in the Special Information section.               <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• If the case is “Title XXI” or “State Funded”, those are <u>not</u> WIC eligible -.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
