Trish is the current Chairperson of the International Affiliation of Tongue Tie Professionals (IATP), a member of the Central Illinois Breastfeeding Task Force (CIBTF), and a former board member of the Illinois chapter of Postpartum Support International (PSI).

She has spoken at conferences locally and internationally on the role of the IBCLC, breast/body feeding difficulties, and in the assessment and management of tongue and lip tie issues in relation to feeding challenges, mental health, and other facets of wellness.
